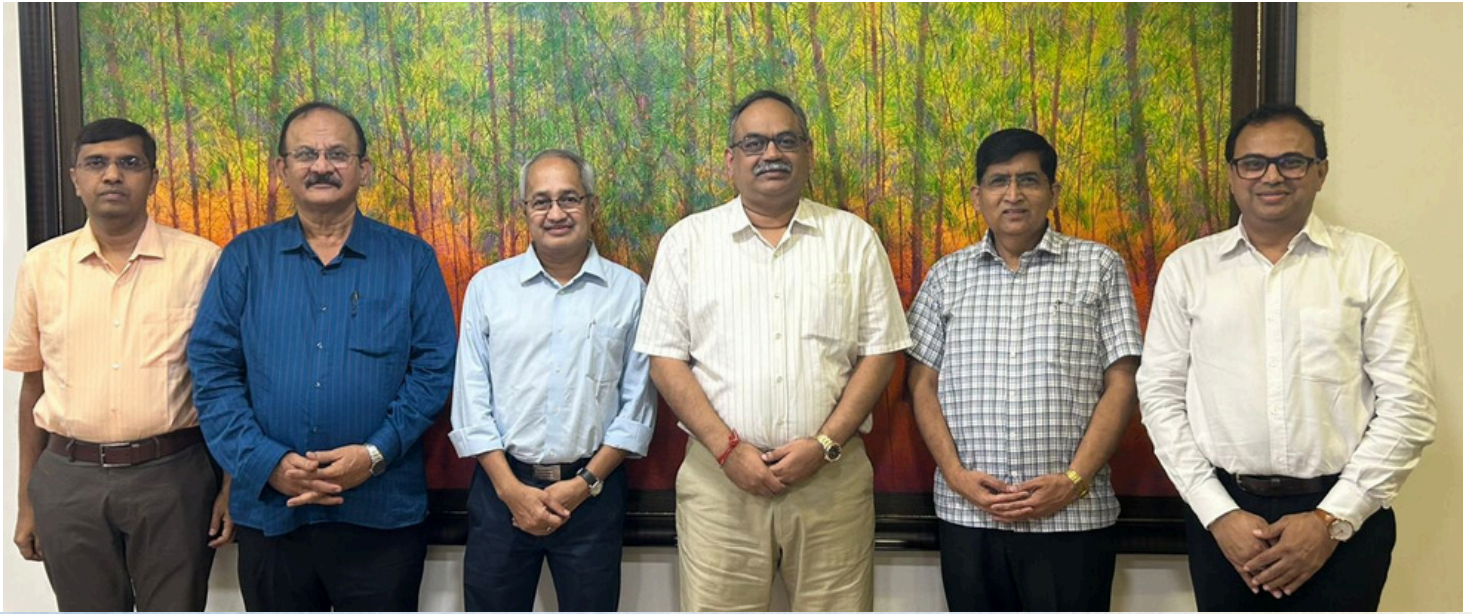

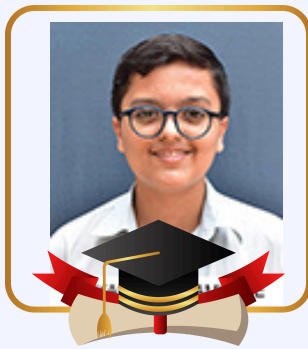

Thanks for reading—may it find a place in your heart, just as it has in ours.

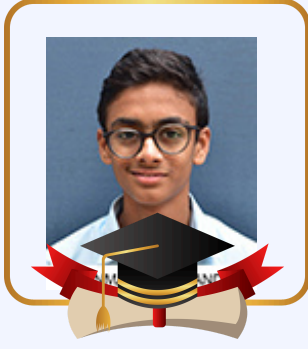

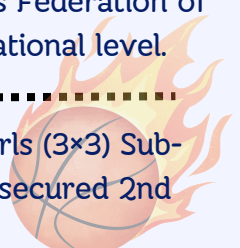
First Prize-Avneesh Paranjape from Std. III secured First Position in the Drawing Competition conducted by the Nagpur Garden Club.
